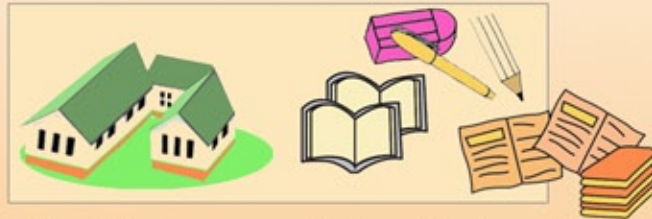
Many poor children in countries like Laos, do not have a chance to go to school.

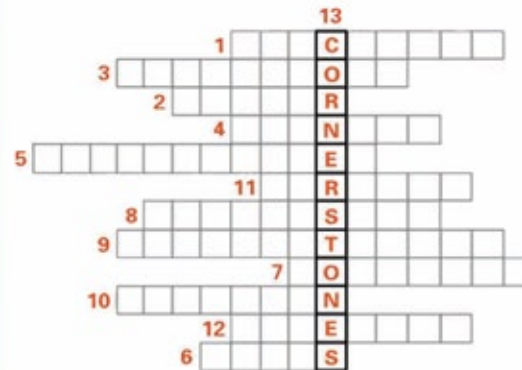
