EDUCATION

The location of the community along the river poses as a challenge for children to attend school. With the poor school infrastructure and low quality of education, around 55% of adolescents dropped out of school by the age of 17.

HEALTH AND NUTRITION

43.6% of children in the district are identified to be underdeveloped for their age due to the lack of nutritional knowledge among caregivers. Preventable diseases caused by lack of clean water and basic hygiene are also commonly seen among children. Furthermore, health services are inaccessible due to poor road conditions.

DISASTER

The district is prone to high occurrences of disasters such as floods and droughts, affecting the livelihoods of families when their crops are destroyed.

CHILD PROTECTION

Domestic violence, abuse and neglect continues to be a prevailing issue in the community due to the lack of awareness of children's rights and poor knowledge and attitude of positive parenting.
