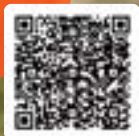

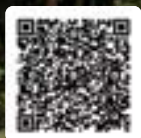

IMPACT STORY: MS NU'S BAMBOO BUSINESS

Ms Nu and her family of five live in rural Quan Son, Vietnam, where they struggled to make ends meet on minimal labour income. Her children often missed school, and buying learning materials was a challenge.

Determined to create a better future, Ms Nu applied for a 15 million VND (~SGD 732) microloan to start a bamboo business. She used the funds to buy fertilisers and hire labourers. Her first harvest earned 39 million VND (~SGD 1,902), enabling her children to attend school regularly, buy supplies, and make much needed home repairs.

"The loan may not be large, but it has helped my family improve so much. With this extra income, I can afford my children's education," shared Ms Nu.

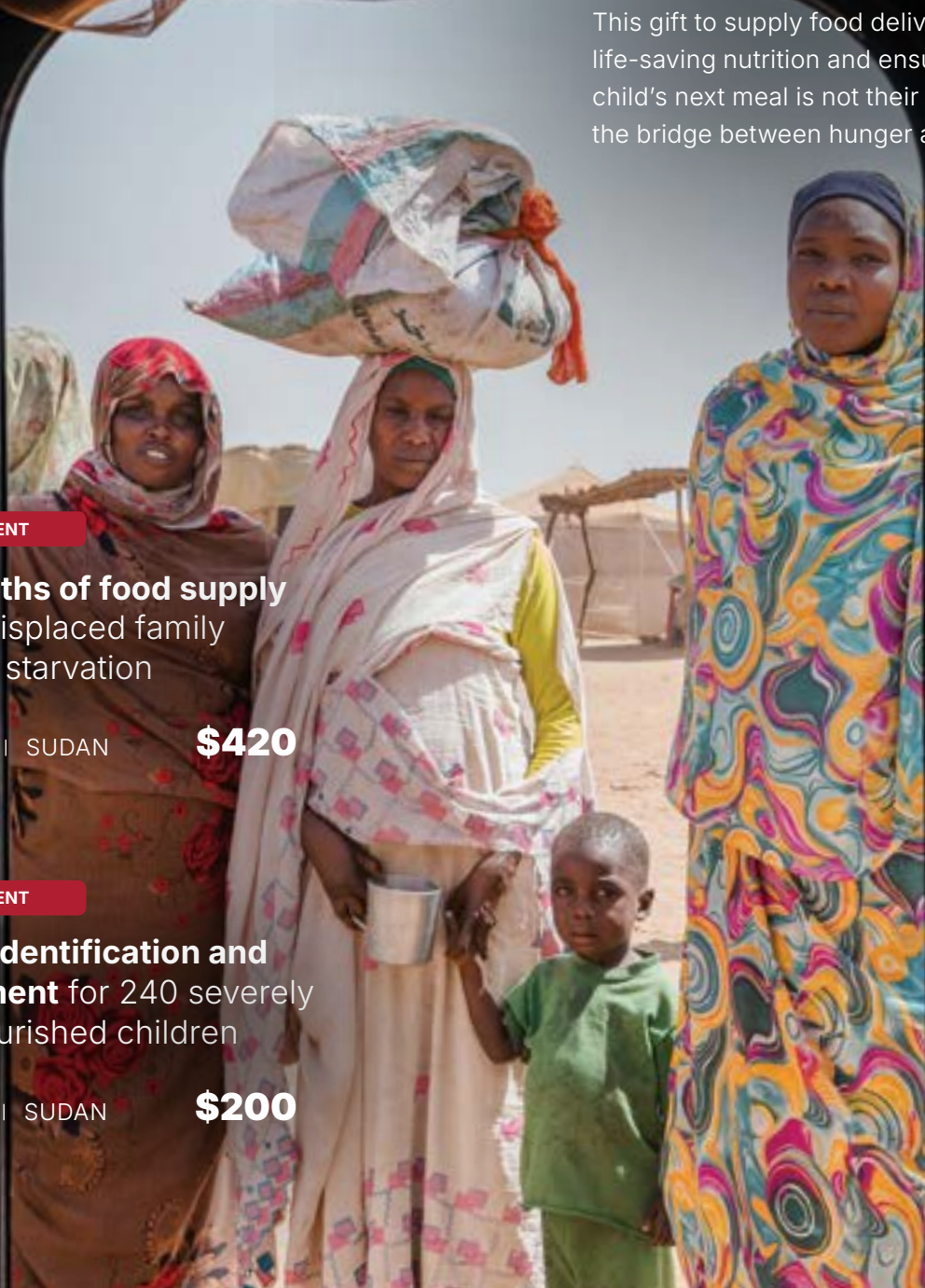

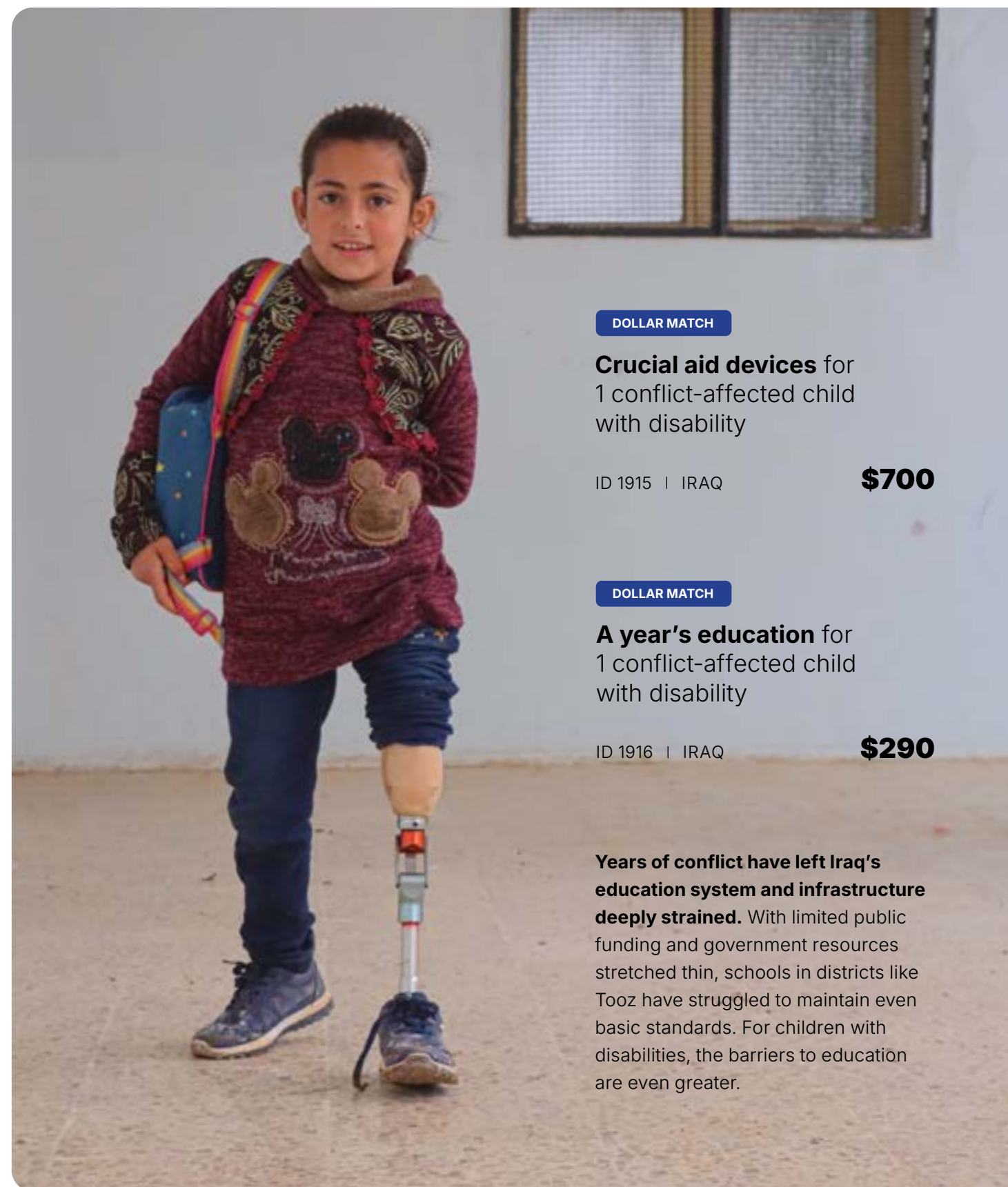

Years of conflict have left Iraq's education system and infrastructure deeply strained. With limited public funding and government resources stretched thin, schools in districts like Tooze have struggled to maintain even basic standards. For children with disabilities, the barriers to education are even greater.

War in Ukraine has destroyed local infrastructure, leaving children to face freezing winters without reliable heat. **What was once a season of warmth is now a battle against the cold**, putting their health and safety at serious risk. During floods, children face heightened risk of drowning, malnutrition, and contracting waterborne diseases. Solar wells and building raised platforms can help provide clean water, and permanent protection for these families.

IMPACT STORY:

BETWEEN SPONSORED CHILD & HER SPONSOR

SREY LA is one of Jia En's sponsored children in Cambodia. She is in Grade 5 and dreams of becoming a teacher in her village.

Before sponsorship, she walked 2 km to school daily, and her family struggled with food shortages, unclean water, no toilet, and limited school supplies. Today, with the support of Child Sponsorship, she has a bicycle for safe travel to school, study materials, and safe drinking water, as well as extra learning support through reading camps. Her family now has a latrine and earns extra income raising chickens.

"I am very happy that World Vision has helped me and my family. Thank you, sponsor. I wish you good health," says Srey La.

JIA EN was introduced to World Vision by a friend, she was moved by the simple yet powerful act of sponsoring a child—a way to make a real and tangible difference, while also encouraging and mentoring through letters.

Growing up, Jia En remembers working her way through university which meant missing out on much of student life. "Those experiences made me value childhood deeply. **I feel strongly about helping children have a more level playing field, so they can live a life they dream of.**"

Now a fitness coach, Jia En sees Child Sponsorship as a natural extension of her passion. Just as athletes thrive with the right nutrition, training, and encouragement, so do children when given education, care, and love.

One letter from her sponsored child in Cambodia, Srey La, left a deep mark on Jia En. It read, "The Khmer New Year is coming. All factory workers, construction workers, and civil servants will have days off. My parents earn less near the Khmer New Year."

Jia En recalls the moment: "For a child to connect a celebratory occasion like New Year to less income for the family—it is heartbreaking.

Reading those words stirred an immediate soft spot in me to want to do more for her, I don't want her to feel 'less than' growing up."

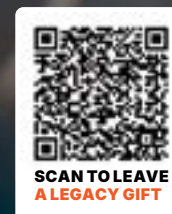

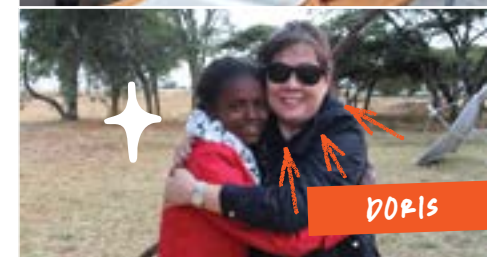
DORIS'S GIFT TO CHILDREN IN AFRICA

One inspiring example is Doris, a Singapore tutor who devoted her life to teaching. When she passed away, she left a legacy gift of over S\$1 million to benefit vulnerable children through World Vision. With her generosity, more than 12,000 young learners in Zambia were able to strengthen their reading skills through lessons, camps, and new classrooms that provided safe learning environments. In Ethiopia, her gift funded the construction of a new school block with classrooms, sanitation facilities, and clean water access, benefitting over 1,300 people, including nearly 400 children.

Through Doris's legacy of love, children in Africa are learning, growing, and reaching for brighter futures.
